TEXAS SKY CANCELS SERVICE FROM DEL RIO TO DALLAS FORT WORTH

Public Charters, Inc., doing business as Texas Sky, will be terminating service from Del Rio Airport (DRT) to Dallas Fort Worth Airport (DFW), effective as of Saturday, Nov. 18, 2017. Texas Sky along with the city, has overcome some of the greatest challenges that a city may face, having re-inaugurated new service after a 4-year intermission.

Both the City of Del Rio and Congressman Hurd's efforts to see that the TSA Fairness Act passed were key factors in the reestablishment of service in Del Rio. Unfortunately, countless marketing tactics and cooperative funding were not enough to break through the air service needs for the community.

Texas Sky has successfully flown over 300 flight segments and delivered many satisfied passengers to and from DFW. Unfortunately the targeted goals for enplanements in order to continue this service have not been reached.

Texas Sky will continue to consider its successes with Del Rio in hopes of restoring service in the future. President and CEO of Texas Sky, James Gallagher, said, "We would like to thank the City of Del Rio and its fine people for supporting the service that was offered.
